1. Visit Rainbow Row; 13 colorful historic houses located at 79 to 107 East Bay Street (North of Tradd St. and South of Elliot St.)
2. Take a walk over the Arthur Ravenel Jr. Bridge. (or New Cooper River Bridge). It's one of the largest cable stayed bridges in the Western Hemisphere and connects downtown Charleston to the town of Mt. Pleasant.
3. Say Hi to Fred. Fred is a wonderful gentleman who out of the goodness of his heart put up Charleston's Free Little Library. He's at 65 Logan Street. Stop by, say Hi and grab a book anytime!
4. Visit any of the area Farmer's Markets that take place throughout the week.
5. See the majestic 1,500-year old Angel Oak Tree on Johns Island.
6. Visit the Firefly Distillery on Wadmalaw Island for a tasting and distillery tour.
7. Splash in the Circular Fountain at Waterfront Park.
